



Amateur Radio Technician Licensing Class

When: Friday, Jan. 6, 2018: 6pm – 9pm, Saturday, Jan. 7, 2018: 9am – 4pm

Cost: *The course is free*, but books or other study aids you may wish to use are not included. Testing is a separate cost.

Book: You don't have to buy a book, there are lots of online resources, but it is highly recommended you purchase one before class. The course is based on the ARRL Ham Radio License Manual 5th Edition – Technician. Knowledge of Morse Code is **no longer** a requirement.

Testing:

1. The testing fee is \$15 (we will supply information on testing locations)
2. Shortly after you pass the FCC will send you an invoice for \$35 to register your license.
