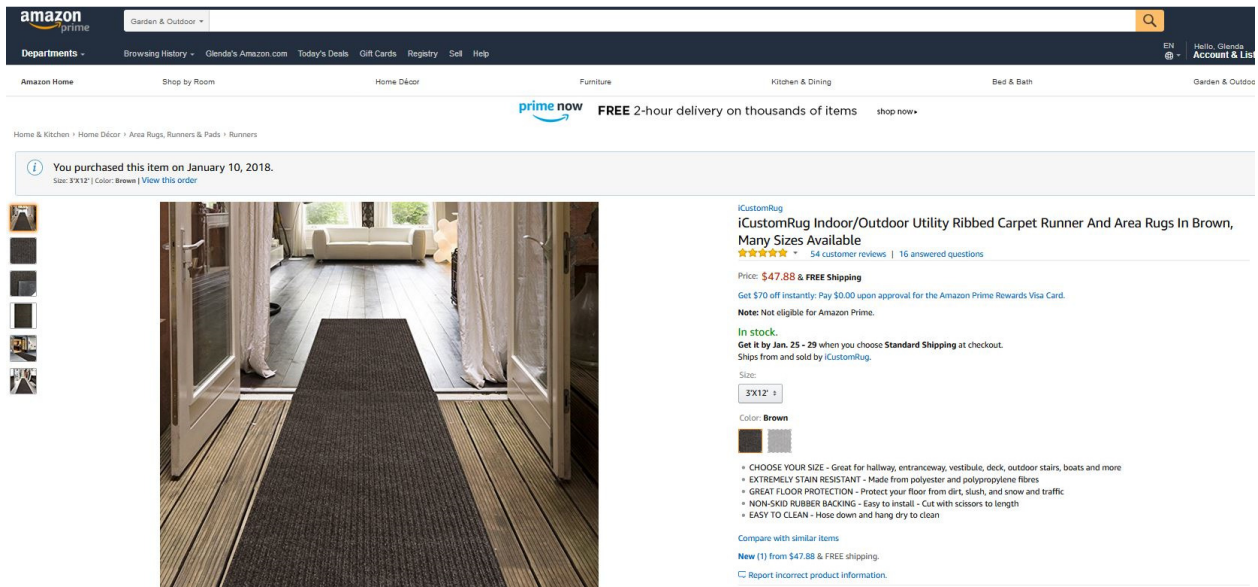


Escape 5.0TA Carpet

I like carpet in my trailer, but don't want any hassles keeping it clean. Carpet runner is inexpensive and durable. It can be cleaned by laying it over a sawhorse in the back yard and squirting it with a garden hose.

I found four foot wide carpet runner on Amazon and the price was right. It is high quality stuff and feels nice underfoot.



I used the back and passenger side edges for reference when measuring the cuts for under the dinette. This insured that the holes for the table post supports were properly aligned. I made the front and driver's side edges slightly oversized and trimmed them with scissors to fit. I made the main cuts with a razor knife with the carpet on a piece of scrap plywood. It is easy to work with and does not need any edge treatment.





The carpet adds a bit of insulation to the underside of the trailer. This was one of my better projects!
